# THE MAESTRO

#### **Artistic Director & Conductor Brett Mitchell**

Hailed for presenting engaging, in-depth explorations of thoughtfully curated programs,



Brett Mitchell marks his second season as Artistic Director & Conductor of Sunriver Music Festival in August 2023. He previously served as Music Director of the Colorado Symphony (2017-21), Associate Conductor of The

Cleveland Orchestra (2013-17), and Assistant Conductor of the Houston Symphony (2007-11) and Orchestre National de France (2006-09).

Mr. Mitchell is also in constant demand as a guest conductor at home and abroad. During the 2022-23 season, he made debuts with the Edmonton Symphony Orchestra and Tulsa Symphony, and reunited for performances with The Cleveland Orchestra, Houston Symphony, and the newly formed San Antonio Philharmonic. Other recent engagements have included appearances with the principal orchestras of Dallas, Detroit, Fort Worth, Indianapolis, Milwaukee, Minnesota, National, North Carolina, Oregon, San Francisco, and the Los Angeles Philharmonic at the Hollywood Bowl. Mr. Mitchell regularly collaborates with the world's leading soloists, including Yo-Yo Ma, Renée Fleming, Itzhak Perlman, among others.

Born in Seattle in 1979, Mr. Mitchell holds degrees in conducting from the University of Texas at Austin and composition from Western Washington University, which selected him as its Young Alumnus of the Year in 2014 and was one of five recipients of the League of American Orchestras' American Conducting Fellowship from 2007 to 2010.




